NOW, THEREFORE, I_ _Mayor of the City of September 22nd as **Arbor Day** in the City of COLFAX ____, and I urge all citizens to celebrate Arbor Day and to support efforts to protect our trees and woodlands, I urge all citizens to plant and care for trees to gladden the heart and promote the Further, well-being of this and future generations.
